

Program Fee & Pay Structure

The 2013-14 Referee Program payment model is payment by Direct Deposit or check.

• We offer a one (1) year (11/15/2013 to 11/14/2014) registration fee: \$100 Regular fee and \$60 Student fee for the SVNJB programs.

To complete the Referee Registration process, follow the instructions for "New" or "Returning" Officials on the <u>Referee Home page</u>.

- The SVNJB year will include the following:
 - Turkey Day Shootout Tournament November 30th & December 1st
 - Winter League Program December 8th, 2013 to mid-March 2014
 - \circ Spring League Program 1st week in April to end of May 2014
 - San Jose Shootout Tournament 2nd weekend in May 2014
 - Summer League Program 3rd week in July 2014
 - o 3 on 3 Tournaments month of September 2014

NJB Payment methods:

- Direct Deposit to your bank account no transaction fee (recommended)
- Payment by check a \$5 fee is deducted from payment to process and mail a check
- A 1099 will be issued to all officials receiving \$600 or more for the calendar year
- You will receive your assignments through the ArbiterSports Game Assignment system:
 - "<u>Arbiter Registration</u>" link can be found on the "Referee Home Page"

Registration Fee Payment Options

Note: Make payment online by credit card for "Full Payment" or "Down payment" amounts

Regular Registration:

- \$100 fee if paid in full on or before November 15th
- \$120 fee if paid in full after November 15th

Plan A:

- \$130 Fee \$50 down payment paid on or before November 15th with the following pay deductions:
 - \circ \$40 December 18th
 - \circ \$40 January 8th
 - o Deduction dates may change depending registration and start date

Plan B:

- \$140 Fee \$0 payment with the following pay deductions:
 - \circ \$50 December 11th
 - \$40 December 18th
 - \circ \$50 January 8th
 - Deduction dates may change depending registration and start date

Full-time Student Registration:

- \$60 fee if paid in full on or before November 15th
- \$70 fee if paid in full after November 15th

Plan C:

- \$75 fee \$25 down payment paid on or before November 15th plus the following pay deduction:
 - \circ \$25 December 11th
 - \circ \$25 December 18th
 - Deduction dates may change depending registration and start date

Plan D:

- \$80 Fee \$0 payment with the following pay deductions:
 - o \$30 December 11th
 - \$25 December 18th
 - o \$25 January 8th

Deduction dates may change depending registration and start date

Key additional Program Info:

- 1. Participation in one (1) Clinic is Mandatory for all Officials
- 2. All Officials are expected to attend one (1) training session (officiating mechanics and NJB philosophy)
- 3. Game fees will be based on your assigned ratings
- 4. SVNJB uses a Rating System to comply with NJB National guidelines
- 5. The game fees below indicate the maximum amount the referee will be paid for each league game officiated based on their rating:

Note: In an effort to align with the National NJB pay structure we have made changes to the following pay levels. See changes in yellow*

HS - High School; AN - All Net; D1 – Division 1; D2 – Division 2; D3 – Division 3

- Elite HS College, High School Officials working this level in other associations
- Elite AN All-Net and/or some experience officiating HS Varsity games
- A All-Net and Divisional highly skilled Officials with several years of experience
- B Divisional Officials with at least 2 years experience and excellent evaluations
- C Divisional less experienced Officials still needing additional entry level training
- S1 Division 1 & 2 Officials attending school with experience and good evaluation
- S2 Division 1 & 2 Officials attending school and new Officials without experience

Note: One (1) referee for a game, referee receives game fee of time and a half

Late Referees:

- Officials showing up after a game has started will have \$10.00 deducted per period which is payable to the on-time official
- The maximum deduction will be \$20.00
- No-shows without prior approve notification will have equivalent game fee deduction
