

A. Why Mandatory Coaches meeting?

- To communicate requirements for certifying their All-Star team
- Ensure All-Stars Coaches know of info needed to certify their team
- Emphasize importance of certifying the Team on the 1st pass:
 - collecting correct documentation
 - submitting correct documentation
- Emphasize collecting documentation now, don't wait
- Sample Certification docs are located on the Section website: <u>www.siliconvalleynjb.com</u> – under Documents, Forms and Reports

In your role as a coach and the Referee's role as a game official, both should work more closely together nurturing our kids in our Silicon Valley NJB program!

- **B.** Sectional Team Qualifying to National Tournaments
 - Two (2) Levels for qualifying "Divisional" All-Star teams
 - 1. Sectional "Divisional" All-Star Tournament
 - March 7, 8, 9 Opening Rounds
 - March 14, 15, 16 Final Rounds

Top Sectional Tournament:

- 1st place team advances to National
- 2nd place team advances to National

Lower Sectional Tournament

- 1st place team advances to National
- 2. National "Divisional" All-Star Tournament March 28, 29, 30
 - 1st place tournament
 - * 1st place winner from Sectional top tournament
 - 2nd place tournament
 - * 2nd place finisher from Sectional top tournament
 - * 1st place winner from Sectional lower tournament

- C. Sectional Team Qualifying to National Tournaments cont
 - 3. Sectional "Non All-Net" All-Star Tournament March 7, 8, 9
 - Host tournaments when enough teams, otherwise teams will receive an at-large birth straight to the National Tournament
 - Play High School rules Sectional & National Tournaments
 - 4. National Tournament "Non All-Net All-Star" Teams play in 2nd level All-Net Tournament March 14, 15, 16
 - 5. Review Sectional All-Star Tournament structure
 - Pool & Bracket Play
 - 3 game minimum in Pool and/or Bracket Play
 - 6. All Qualifying teams will receive a National Tournament info sheet
 - Teams will need to reserve hotel rooms for the Nationals in advance

- E. Certification for the Sectional Tournament consist of
 - No binders
 - No sleeves
 - Team Certification documents paper clipped in the following order:
 - NJB All-Star Team Worksheet/Roster type Team data into the printable MSWord version doc located on the Silicon Valley Section website no Excel or hand type Roster (located on Section website)
 - Birth Record birth certificate, adoption papers, immigration papers or passports
 - NOT ACCEPTED baptismal records, hospital records, school letters, medical cards
 - age meets grade level limits
 - Current Report Card latest progress report acceptable
 - no letters in lieu of report cards
 - 2.0 GPA (upper grades) and Satisfactory standing (lower grades)
 or required this season
 - proof of grade
 - Proof of Address current utility bill (gas, water or electric)
 - * NO cell phone bills
 - -- * Online utility bills OK if name and address listed
 - 1 individual picture affixed to 11 x 8.5 sheet of paper close-up shot

F. Other All-Star information:

- A full team picture required for advancement to the National tournament – uploaded to HQ website
- All players must have their uniform number readable in the picture for the Nationals
- All teams advancing to National must signup online
- Each All-Star player must have played 5 regular season games
- A Player can play up in a Division during the Regular Season and then play down in a Division for All-Stars
- 10 players maximum per team
- Coaches MUST submit a Lopsided Score Report for all point differences of 35 points or more. Form located on Section website
- Consequences may be administered for running up a score

G. All-Star Tournament Rules:

2013-14 Rules & Regulation Booklet versus 2014 Area/Sectional All-Star rules

- The Sectional All-Star Coaches Package "will be" available on the Section website: www.siliconvalleynjb.com under Documents, Forms & Reports "this weekend"
- The National All-Star Coaches Package will be posted to the Section website when NJB HQ releases it some time next week
- There are differences between the Sectional and Nationals operation of the tournament such as, we here in the Section allow a scorekeeper on the bench but at the end of the bench. No scorekeeper is allow at Nationals unless it is a coach. National allows two (2) bench coaches
- The Player Advantage Rule as defined in the Rules Booklet distributed by HQ will be in effect during the Sectional and the National Tournaments and there are differences from the Regular Season rule

- **H.** All-Star Tournament Information:
 - Gym Management clean bench area after your game
 - Game Items Only Player Participation rule can be protested
 - Coach must present <u>Roster</u> to score table on game day
- I. Coaches remind your parents that there will be an entry fee for the Sectional All-Star games. The entry fees are to cover:
 - Gym/facility costs
 - Referees
 - Scorekeepers

- L. End meeting
