Our 2014 Stars AAU Tournament Play Season will consist of eight (8) tournaments. Key activities and timeframe includes:

- Tryouts and Team Selection – mid-January through the 2nd week of February
- Practice Starts – 1st part of March
- Uniform Sizing – 2nd week in February
- Tournament Play Season – 1st part of April through end of July

We look forward to the players selected to the Stars teams learning a lot about the game of basketball as they strive to improve for the next level.

The Player Participation fee is \$1300 and includes the following:

- Two (2) Player Skill Development Sessions per month (Apr – Jun) to enhance player development
 - Stars Coaches working with high skilled Clinicians will lead these sessions
- 8 tournaments consisting of 24 games or more – tournaments will be identified at a later date before the tryouts conclude
- 2 Custom Uniforms for Home and Away games
- Custom Stars Select T-Shirt
- Customized Shooter Shirt with player # (warmup pants are optional pending fundraiser revenue)
- Team gear includes: balls, bags, scorebooks, clipboards, practice gear & equipment
- Gym practice time of 3 – 5 hours per week in an insured facility – starts 1st part of March
- AAU Club, Player and Coaches fees
- Player Insurance
- Dedicated Coaches
- Administrative fees for Coaches and Staff
- Coaches lodging and transportation for travel tournaments
- Payment options are available for the Player's fee – full payment will be accepted
- Note: Winter NJB teams receive priority for conflicts until the Winter season concludes

What the SV Stars Player fee does not cover:

- \$25 Tryout fee which allow player to attend all scheduled tryouts
- Two (2) Open Gym nights per month for pick-up games Playground style alternating on Friday nights with the Skills Development Sessions - \$5 per attendance (March – June)
- Player travel and lodging for travel tournaments – parents responsibility
- Any additional tournaments played beyond the 8 covered in the Program, will be funded by the families of the team. For example, a typically AAU tournament may cost \$350. If there are 10 players on a team for a \$350 tournament, it would require each player's parent to pay \$35.00 each for that additional tournament. **Note:** A prorated coaches stipend will also apply
- All additional scheduled tournaments played under the SV Stars Program, must be paid, managed and registered through the Stars Program
- Player bags and t-shirts targeted to be funded by the Program Fundraiser – more info to follow

Participation in the SV Stars Program will require the parents to sign a Promissory Note:

- The Promissory Note will specify what services the Player/Parents will receive from the SV Stars Program
- The Promissory Note will help insure that the SV Stars Program will be paid for services budgeted and rendered for the SV Stars Program Tournament Play Season
- It is mandatory that all Player fees be collected in order to pay the expenses of the Program
