

Section League History

In San Jose, NJB was initiated by John Williams in 1990. It started with 9 teams in 3 cities. There were 180 kids in the 1st year. Keith Ivy was appointed Sectional Director in 1993. Today there are over 4000 boys and girls participating in the Silicon Valley NJB Section consisting of 13 Programs (Chapters). Mel Robertson is the current Sectional Director. The Willow Glen program started for the 2002 - 03 season. With the Foothill Chapter being the most recent and it's potential for growth, we expected growth in the Gilroy/Morgan Hill area and also received growth up the Peninsula with the Redwood and Palo Alto Chapters:
